

PERIODONTAL SENIOR CASE COMPETENCY – EVALUATION OF THERAPY

Note: *Completion of the Periodontal Re-Evaluation is the absolute minimum requirement for completion of the Senior Periodontal Case Competency. Passing the Senior Periodontal Case Competency requires completion of the patient's periodontal treatment through this stage, and the student must have accumulated ≥ 70 points on the case to receive a passing grade.*

- Periodontal maintenance therapy should be provided initially at 2 months following the periodontal re-evaluation. Subsequent periodontal recalls may be at 2-4 month intervals as agreed upon in the final treatment plan. All periodontal recalls must be performed under supervision of Periodontics faculty.

Senior Periodontal Competency Case Completion & Evaluation of Therapy:

Students are expected to provide appropriate periodontal therapy for their patient throughout the course of treatment. Periodontal and restorative treatment should address all specified periodontal problems and risk factors and should be appropriately sequenced relative to the patient's restorative and prosthodontic treatment needs. Following completion of non-surgical and surgical periodontal therapy, the student must provide regular periodontal maintenance therapy for their patient at 2 to 3 month intervals until the last semester of their senior year. **Consequently, no Senior Periodontal Competency Case will be signed off as completed before February 1st of the senior year.** Satisfactory completion of the Senior Periodontal Competency Case requires:

1. Performance of the last periodontal maintenance therapy for the patient
2. A formal evaluation of the periodontal therapy provided for the patient.

Senior Periodontal Case Competency Evaluation of Therapy Grade:

The Senior Periodontal Case Competency receives three grades, one for the Senior Periodontal Case work-up, one for the Senior Periodontal Case Re-evaluation, and one for Senior Periodontal Case Completion-Evaluation of Therapy.

- **The Senior Periodontal Case Completion Evaluation of Therapy grade** is based upon the number of points awarded for completion of critical steps in the Periodontal treatment plan and accurate assessments of treatment outcomes, as indicated on the attached grading rubric. The amount of points awarded at each step is influenced by the student's appropriate management of the case. **Passing this competency requires completion of the patient's periodontal treatment through Re-evaluation, and the student must have accumulated an adequate number of points on the case for a passing grade of ≥ 70 .** The numeric Senior Periodontal Case completion grade will be averaged with the Senior Periodontal Case Competency Re-evaluation grade. This numeric average will be converted to a letter grade (A=90-100; B=80-89; C=70-79, D=60-69) which will count toward the student's grade in Spring semester Senior Year Comprehensive Care Clinic (COMC 5902). Failure to pass the Senior Periodontal Case Completion Evaluation of Therapy Competency before the end of the spring semester of the senior year will result in an incomplete grade in COMC 5902, and will require remediation of case deficiencies.
