

**DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH AWARD**  
**NOMINATION FORM**

This award recognizes an individual who has made significant sustained contributions to research that provides insights into mechanisms of disease prevention, detection or therapy. The nominee's research may be focused on basic science, clinical science, clinical outcomes and/or epidemiological research. The nominee should also have displayed outstanding mentoring and leadership qualities. Nominations must be submitted by two independent faculty on two separate forms (no self nominations). Nomination forms, letters, current CV and supporting documentation should be submitted to the Vice President for Research, Dr. Frank Treiber, CJ-3317 or [ftreiber@mcg.edu](mailto:ftreiber@mcg.edu), no later than **August 1, 2006**. Nominations will be considered by an interdisciplinary panel of scientists at MCG. Committee selections to be made by September 15, 2006, and announced at a banquet celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Medical College of Georgia Research Institute (MCGRI) on October 20, 2006. This award is non-renewable and awarded to two individuals.

*All letters of nomination must address each of the following criteria eligibility:*

**Eligibility Criteria**

- Active Full time, Part time (whose primary appointment is at MCG) or Emeritus Faculty are eligible
- Minimum of 5 years MCG Service
- Scientific contributions should be recognized nationally and internationally for example:
  - Citations in preeminent scientific journals
  - Membership on expert panels
  - Sustained extramural funding
  - Awards
  - Elite national honor societies
  - Invited addresses
- Evidence of outstanding mentoring and leadership qualities
