

EMERGING SCIENTIST AWARD
NOMINATION FORM

The recipient of the Emerging Scientist award is given to a full-time faculty member who is early in their research career. This individual should be beginning to make outstanding contributions to research that provide insights into mechanisms of disease prevention, detection or therapy. Preferred candidates should have demonstrated distinguished scholarly activity, a track record of extramural support and contributions to the research programs at MCG. **The scope of the individual's research could be focused on basic science, clinical science, clinical outcomes and/or epidemiological research.** All full time faculty who have been at MCG for 5 years or less at a rank no higher than Associate Professor are eligible. Nominations must be submitted by two independent faculty on two separate forms (no self nominations). Nomination forms, letters, current CV and supporting documentation should be submitted to the Vice President for Research, Dr. Frank Treiber, CJ-3317 or ftreiber@mcg.edu, no later than **August 1, 2006**. Nominations will be considered by an interdisciplinary panel of scientists at MCG. Committee selections to be made by September 15, 2006, and announced at a banquet celebrating the 25th Anniversary of the Medical College of Georgia Research Institute (MCGRI) on October 20, 2006. This award is non-renewable.

All letters of nomination must address each of the following criteria eligibility:

Eligibility Criteria

- Active Full time Faculty
- 5 years or less MCG Service at a rank no higher than Associate Professor
- Scientific contributions should be recognized nationally for example:
 - Publications in top tier journals
 - Professional Society Awards
 - A record of extramural support
 - Contributions to the MCG research program
