Policy Statement

A student at the Medical College of Georgia forfeits credit toward graduation for a course if the student has already received credit for that course, that is, if the student is repeating the course. The final grade in that course, for graduation purposes, will be the grade in the repeated course; however, all hours attempted and grades earned will appear on the transcript and be used in computing the grade point average.

Reason For Policy

This policy ensures that students do not receive credit more than once for a course that he/she takes at the Medical College of Georgia.

All students who are enrolled at the Medical College of Georgia are affected by this policy.

Who Should Read This Policy

All students who are enrolled at the Medical College of Georgia, the faculty who teach them, and the staff who provide administrative services to them are affected by this policy.
