Policy Statement

Animals of any kind, with the exception of aquatic fish in aquariums of 10 gallons or less, are prohibited from Medical College of Georgia residence halls or adjacent grounds.

Reason For Policy

This policy was established to ensure that residence hall facilities at the Medical College of Georgia are clean, sanitary, safe, and well maintained.

Entities Affected By This Policy

All students at the Medical College of Georgia who are interested in living in campus housing are affected by this policy.

Who Should Read This Policy

Students who choose to live in Medical College of Georgia residence halls should be aware of this policy.

Students are prohibited from having animals of any type in Medical College of Georgia residence halls or on adjacent grounds, with the exception of aquatic fish in aquariums of 10 gallons or less.

Process/Procedures

Students contracting to live in Medical College of Georgia residence hall facilities are required to adhere to the pet policy as stated herein and in the Residence Life Housing Agreement. Failure to do so may result in termination of the agreement by the Medical College of Georgia and forfeiture of prepaid housing fees.
