

MCG Academy of Medical Educators Selection Process

All Academy members must have a faculty appointment in the School of Medicine. All applicants should be recognized as outstanding teachers of medical students OR have significant impact on medical student education through their educational activities with residents, fellows, or graduate students. Additionally, candidates should demonstrate excellence in the form of outstanding accomplishments in one or more of the following educational activities:

- Curriculum development
- Evaluation of learner performance
- Advising and/or mentoring of medical students, residents, and/or faculty
- Educational administration and/or leadership

Application packets will be reviewed by a panel of internal and external reviewers.

Each application packet will be reviewed by **three (3) external reviewers** who are nationally known and respected in the field of medical education.

Each application packet will be reviewed by **three (3) internal reviewers** who are current members of the MCG Academy of Medical Educators. One of the three internal reviewers must be a member of the Academy Selection Committee.

Members will be selected by a consensus of reviewers. The criteria for acceptance will be based upon the documentation and quality of the candidate's direct teaching activities, other educational activities, personal statement, and plans for service contributions to the Institution.
