

STUDENT ORIENTATION FOR INPATIENT ROTATION AND CALL

Team System: The Pediatric service is divided into 4 or 5 teams (depending on the season):

- 1 General 1 - Includes General/Adolescent, and Endocrinology
- 2 General 2 – Includes General/Adolescent, GI, and Rheumatology (during the summer the two General teams are combined)
- 3 Hospitalist – Includes complex general/adolescent, surgical, and pulmonology
- 4 Subspecialty – includes patients from hematology-oncology, nephrology, and cardiology
- 5 Cardiology – primarily outpatient, also seeing cardiology inpatients in the NICU and PICU

Housestaff Structure: These teams work independently and have a specific schedule for rounds and lectures. See posted Orientation materials and Master Schedule for each team.

Team Assignments: The attending and supervising residents will orient students to assigned team.

General Attending/Chief Rounds: The General Attending will round with all students assigned to inpatient and nursery on Thursdays at 2pm. The Chief Resident will host Jeopardy on the 2nd Monday of each 2 week block at 3pm.

Lectures: All students are **ENCOURAGED** to attend the lectures. They have been recorded and are available on Vista for students working at community sites.

Completing the Rotation: Students on the inpatient ward may consider their clerkship finished once they have taken the final examination and completed all their off-service notes on their patients. If off-service notes are not done on Friday, students will be required to come in on Saturday to do them.

JMS Call

Call: Call is assigned according to the schedule below.

Meals: Students will not be given meal allocations to cover their meal expenses when on call.

Post-Call: Students may go home post-call after noon-conference and after their daily notes are complete. The student must check-out their patients with their resident before leaving.

Weekends/Holidays: On weekends and holidays students on the inpatient service will round with the team and assist with completion of clinical work and late morning admissions. There are no weekend or holiday duties during the four weeks of nursery/outpatient.

Changes: Trades between students are permitted with both students' permission as long as there are not two students from the same team on call the same night (except on Fri. or Sat. nights).
Rationale: we don't want both students on the team gone post-call at the same time.
